Bidart Services From Treadway's Next Saturday

Funeral services for John Bidart, a former resident of Napa who died suddenly early Tuesday in Drummond, Montana, will be held here Saturday at 2 p. m. under the auspices of the Fraternal Order of Eagles from Treadway Chapel.

Bidart was born in San Francisco in 1894 but came to Napa in 1904 where he was educated in local grammar schools and later was employed by the Sawyer Tanning Company for about 12 years.
