John Clos Accidentally Killed While Loading His Wagon

John Clos met death in a rude manner yesterday afternoon at the Sentous slaughter house on the Cienega ranch. Clos was engaged in unloading some heavy casks from a wagon. The casks are used to hold lard and are nearly 500 pounds in weight. One of them was being let down on a plank when the cask slipped and struck Clos, knocking him down. The cask fell on his head and the skull was crushed, death resulting almost instantly. Clos was a man 28 years of age and had a wife residing near the scene of the accident. The body was removed to the undertaking rooms of Orr & Hines, where an inquest will be held.
