Coroner Campbell held an inquest yesterday on the remains of John Clos, the Frenchman killed at Sentous's slaughter-house Thursday afternoon. The evidence showed that Clos was helping load a heavy cask when it slipped on the plank. As Clos was in a stooping position, the cask rolled on top of his head and killed him instantly. A verdict of accidental death was rendered.
