

Calabasas Row Dismissed

Vicente and Juan Yturralde of Calabasas, a couple of Spanish Basque sheepmen, were on trial yesterday in the township justice court on the charge of having on January 18th, in the presence of several parties, exhibited a rifle in a rude manner, which Manuel Dominguez, the plaintiff, considered threatening. The trouble arose over a question of pasturing sheep on Dominguez' land. It was in evidence that it led to bad language, but nothing out of the way for Calabasas, where such pastimes are absolutely au fait. Justice Young dismissed the complaint against the Yturraldes when he had heard all that the Dominguez faction had to impart.
