

DOMINGUEZ'S TRIAL

Calabasas to the Fore Again in the Superior Court

The trial of Manuel Dominguez of Calabasas was commenced yesterday in Department one of the superior court. The information accuses Manuel of having assaulted Vicente Yturralde, a sheepman, on Feb. 3th, by shooting him with a revolver with intent to murder him. The facts were fully published at the time.

The affray was the result of an attempt on the part of Yturralde to pasture his sheep upon land to which Dominguez laid claim. The men met, and, according to the prosecuting witness, Dominguez shot him without provocation. On the other hand the defendant says that he did none of the shooting, but that Yturralde was shot by his own kinsman, who was attempting to fill Manuel full of lead.
