He Tells How Yturralde Caught Bullets Meant for Himself

The case of Manuel Dominguez, charged with shooting Vicente Yturralde at Calabasas, will go to the jury on Monday after Deputy District Attorney McComas has finished the concluding argument for the people.

The defendant and his relatives told a story yesterday of how Yturrade had caught him from behind, snatching away his big revolver and called upon his hired man to shoot Manuel while he held him. The hired man was only fifteen feet away, but Manuel was so good a doger that every time a shot was fired he escaped it, and Yturralde, who stood right behind him, caught it in some part of the body. When court adjourned the whole Dominguez contingent, consisting of women and children, as well as several Mexican gentlemen of Calabasas, crowded around the clerk for an order for their expenses upon the treasurer.
