

HANGING ON TREE.**GOATHERD TIRED OF WORK.****[SPECIAL CORRESPONDENCE OF THE TIMES]**

CORONA, May 9—Pedro Arambel, a Basque goatherd, was found hanging to a tree one and one-half miles west of Rincon this morning. When last seen alive at 8 o'clock last evening Arambel is said to have been acting queerly. The verdict of the Coroner's jury was that he came to his death by his own hand: He never carried money and was not known to have enemies. Arambel was a bachelor, a native of Spain, 44 years old, and had lived in this vicinity eighteen years. Two brothers and a step-sister live in Los Angeles. Arambel had 2000 Angora goats at Rincon, and camped forty rods from where he hanged himself. He left an unsigned note written in Basque, evidently intended for his will, as he tells to whom portions of his herd of goats belong and says he was tired of herding goats.
