

**FUNERAL OF A PARIS
MINER THIS MORNING**

The funeral of Joé Tuculet, who was caught under falling rock at the Paris mines last Saturday and died shortly after from the injuries, will be held at the St. Joseph church in Kern this morning at 10 o'clock, under the direction of Dixon & Sons. Father Leo will officiate.

Tuculet was a native of France, having resided the last seventeen years in California and for the last two years he has been connected with the Paris mines. He leaves a wife and four little children. At the time of his death he was 38 years of age and was extensively acquainted in the Paris mines district, Tehachapi and Bakersfield.

The friends wishing to view the remains should meet at the Dixon parlors at 9:30 a. m., shortly after which hour the body will be taken to Kern.
