Jean Pierre Daguerre died in a Los Angeles hospital Friday evening as a result of the accident sustained in a runaway which occurred the week previous. The accident happened on the road half way between El Toro and San Juan Capistrano, near the Oso canyon.	
Daguerre, who, in partnership with Louis Moniton, owns a large ranch near El Toro, consisting of about 23, 000 acres, was looking after his bus- iness in connection with the catile and sheep raising of the ranch. At	
the top of the hill at the Oso canyon he met a sheepherder, and was giving him some instructions about his work, Daguerre was driving a fine pair of norses which had a great deal of life in them.	
•While talking to the sheephetder, an automobile approached, and Da- guerre told the sheepherder to stand at the head of his team. As the ma- chine got nearer, and made a great racket, the team took fright and lung	
ed forward. The sheepherder let go of the horses and they plunged down the hil. One single-tree was broken, and the tongue dropped to the ground. Daguerre was thrown from the fig and his chest was crushed in. O Friday he was taken to a hos
