

Father and Son Die Within 12 Hours of Each Other

LOS ANGELES, Dec. 7.—Friends of Louis Sentous and his son, Jules, prominent meat packers of this city and members of an old family, were astounded today to learn that the two men had died within twelve hours of each other yesterday. The elder Sentous, who founded a large packing company here, died at 6 o'clock in the morning, having succumbed to heart failure. The son died at 6 o'clock at night, his death having been due to pneumonia.
