

PIONEER OF MISSION VALLEY PASSES AWAY

Domingo Oyharzabal, Wealthy
Mission Valley Land Owner,
is Dead

Yesterday Domingo Oyharzabal of San Juan Capistrano died in Los Angeles after an illness of several weeks. For some time it was known that he could not recover from his illness.

Oyharzabal was born in Basses, Pyrennes, France, in 1846. He settled in San Juan Capistrano in 1878, and gradually accumulated property, so that for some years past he has owned over 4000 acres in the mission valley, including a fine walnut grove of 150 acres. For years he was one of the leading sheep men of the county. At one time he owned 25,000 sheep. It is understood that his property goes to his brother, who has been living at San Juan Capistrano. He was unmarried.
