

FAMILY SQUABBLE.
SLANDER CASE NON-SUITED.

A slander suit for \$50,000 damages brought by Martin and Clarence Zubieta, brothers, against their uncle, Benito Sesma, blew up in Judge Works's court yesterday when Attorney Appel, representing Sesma, was granted a non-suit.

The Zubieta boys, aged 17 and 13 respectively, alleged that Uncle Benito threatened to put them out of their grocery business at any cost, and called them thieves. The evidence was not sufficient to show that the partnership had been damaged in reputation and credit, as alleged.

Sesma, it appears, had brought his nephews from Spain and set them up in the grocery business on East Seventh street. Later the boys bought him out, and then the alleged trouble is said to have followed.
