

**MRS. SENTOUS TAKEN.**

**Mother of French Consul, Seventy  
Years a Resident of Los  
Angeles, Expires.**

Mrs. Theodora Casanova Sentous, mother of Louis Sentous, French Consul, and for seventy years a resident of Los Angeles, died yesterday morning suddenly at her home, No. 1224 Magnolia avenue, where she lived with her daughter, Camille.

Mrs. Sentous was born in Costa Rica in 1847. Her father came from Catalonia, Spain, and her mother was a native of Venezuela. When she was only a year old her parents brought her to Los Angeles, and here she has lived ever since.

Mrs. Sentous belonged to the French Red Cross and to the French Ladies' Society. Her six children are Mrs. Narcisse M. Sentous, Louis Sentous and Camille Sentous, of this city; Mrs. Heloise M. Lewis of Hollywood and Frank P. Sentous of Newhall, now in the city; and Mrs. W. L. Truitt of Eureka.

Funeral arrangements will not be made until Mrs. Truitt is heard from. Interment is to be in Calvary Cemetery, where Mrs. Sentous's husband lies.
