A solemn requiem high mass was held yesterday morning in St. Francis' church for Paul Galtes, one of the pioneer business men of Bakersfield. Rev. Paul Galtes of Spokane, son of the deceased, conducted the service, assisted by Rev. Phillip Seher of St. Francis church as deacon, and by Rev. John Egan of St. Joseph's church, as sub-deacon. A very large crowd of old friends and sympathizers assembled at the church and followed the body to its last resting place in the family vault in Union cemetery. Many exquisite floral tokens of sorrow were sent to the family home on Truxtun avenue, where the body lay in state until the funeral hour, and to the church in the morning.
