

## \$45,000 ESTATE LEFT BY COUNTY PIONEER

Huntington Beach town and country property make up the bulk of a \$45,000 estate left by Roch Courreges, pioneer, who died at Talbert May 4, according to a petition by his son, Joseph, and Henry Lacabanne, to probate the will. The petition was on file today in the superior court.

Sixty acres near Huntington Beach are valued at \$20,000. Twenty-three lots in Huntington Beach are said to be worth \$4,000. The rest of the estate consists of notes and other securities.

Heirs under the will are the widow, Marie Courreges, the son, Joseph Courreges, Huntington Beach, John Courreges, another son residing in Los Angeles, and three daughters, Elizabeth Lacabanne, Los Angeles, Phillipine Lacabanne, Huntington Beach, and Jessie Landin, Los Angeles.
