

MRS. SAHARGUN DIES AFTER NURSING SON THROUGH SICKNESS

A mother who gave her life in devotion to her boy was Mrs. Josephine Sahargun of Mendota who passed away yesterday at the home of her sister, Mrs. Marie Arbios, 1130 North Edison street.

When the 17-year old son, John Sahargun, who attends Stockton high school, became ill about two weeks ago the devoted mother left her home in Mendota and came here to nurse him back to health, disregarding the danger of exposure to disease. She fell ill while caring for her son and gradually weakened until the end came. The son has recovered. The father died several years ago.

Mrs. Sahargun was formerly a nurse at the Lane hospital in San Francisco. She is survived by a sister, Anna Nout of West Alhambra, California; a brother, Joseph Daunet of France, besides Mrs. Arbois. She also leaves her mother, Mrs. Balbino Daunet, who lives in France.

The deceased was born in France almost exactly 38 years ago, since her birthday fell on March the third.
