

WOMAN IS VICTIM OF GAS BLAZE

Burns in Clothing Fire Fatal to Aged Matron on Imperial Street

Mrs. Frances Leonis, 73 years of age, 613 Imperial street, died yesterday in Lincoln Hospial of burns received earlier in the day when her clothing caught fire at a gas heater.

Mrs. Leonis ran screaming outdoors. Mrs. Mamie Barron, a negress, ran to her aid and beat out
the flames, but Mrs. Leonis had
been burned from head to foot.
She was taken to the Receiving
Hospital and attended by Police
Surgeon Dorn, then transferred to
Lincoln Hospital.

She was the mother of J. B. Leonis, a banker of Vernon, and of Michael A. Leonis, superintendent of the Globe Cotton Oil Mills. Her grand-daughter, Marie Mosquini, is a film actress at the Hal Roach studio.
