

## Kern Death Toll Since January 1 Increases To 14

BAKERSFIELD, Jan. 17.—Kern county's violent death toll since the first of the year jumped to 14 today when two accident victims died at local hospitals. The two new names on the January tragely list are those of B. V. Brown, 38, Santa Fe brakeman, who was injured in a railroad accident at Mojave early yesterday, and Mrs. Jennie Iribarne, 23-year-old Kern matron, who was seriously burned in a coal oil explosion at her home more than a month ago. Brown, who lost a portion of his right foot when he slipped and fell under the grinding wheels of a train at Mojave, died as the result of shock and loss of blood. His head also was injured. The body is at Flickinger mortuary, where an inquest will be conducted Friday. The railroad man is survived in Los Angeles by his widow and two children.

Mrs. Iribarne leaves, in addition to her husband, three children—Josephine, Joe and Steve Iribarne. She was a native of Kern county and resided here her entire life. Mass will be solemnized at 9 o'clock Saturday morning at St. Francis church. Arrangements are in charge of Hopson mortuary.
