GUN ACCIDENT FATAL

LOS BANOS (Merced Co.), Aug.
3.—George B. Menjoulet, prominent
Los Banos rancher, was killed
about noon Saturday by the discharge of his own 410 gauge shotsum as he was pulling the gun out
of the automobile in which he had
been riding on his property known as
Menjoulet Canyon, nine miles
southwest of Los Banos.
Menjoulet left Los Banos alone
alout 10 'clock Saturday morning, intending to go to the ranch
to polson some squirrels before
noon. He is thought to have put
out the poison and returned to his
car to get the gun to shoot the
squirrel or perhaps a jackrabbit.
He pulled the gun, muzzle first,
out of the car. The weapon somehow was discharged, the shot striking him in the temple just back of
the eye. Death is thought to
have been instantaneous.
Mrs. Menjoulet became worried
when her husband did not return
to their home for lunch, and drove
out to look for him but, failing to
find him, turned around and returned. When he did not return
iater in the day, she drove to the
home of her brother-in-law, Henry
Wenjoulet, at Volta. Henry Menjoulet, his wife and two children
invose out to Menjoulet Conyon,
finding the body about 6 cilcok in
the evening.

making an investigation, declared
that death could not have been
