

**J. F. BASTANCHURY
DIES IN HOSPITAL**

Joseph Francis Bastanchury, member of one of Orange county's pioneer families, passed away early this morning in St. Joseph hospital following a brief illness. He was 53 years of age. He resided on the Bastanchury ranch north of Fullerton.

Surviving are the widow, Juanita; three daughters, Juanita, Benisia and Marie, all of the Fullerton ranch; a son, Joseph jr.; his mother, Maria Bastanchury, and three brothers, Gaston, Dominic, and John.

Mr. Bastanchury, born in Anaheim, had lived on the family ranch all of his life. Recitation of the Holy Rosary will be Wednesday evening at 8 o'clock in the McAulay and Suters chapel in Fullerton. Requiem mass will be sung in St. Mary's Catholic church, Fullerton, Thursday at 9 a. m. Interment is to be at the family vault in Calvary cemetery, Los Angeles.
