Her Father Was Fourth Mayor of Los Angeles

Mrs. Constance Mascarel Penilla, 77, descendant of a pioneer Southern California Spanish family, died yesterday at her home, 800 Summit Ave., following an illness of several months.

She was the daughter of Jose Mascarel, fourth Mayor of Los Angeles who held office in 1865-66.

Rosary will be recited tomorrow at 7:30 p.m. at Garrett Bros. Mortuary and requiem mass will be celebrated for her Friday at 9 a.m. at San Antonio Parish Church on Pleasant Ave. Burial will be in Calvary Cemetery.
