

Services for John Etchart to be Held In Glasgow Wednesday

GLASGOW, April 19. (U.P.) — Funeral services will be held here Wednesday at St. Raphael's church for John Etchart, 60, leading Montana stockman who died of a heart attack Saturday night while talking to friends at a downtown store.

Etchart, born of a family of sheep raisers, came to Montana in 1912 from Elko, Nev., and settled near Hinsdale. His holdings extended through the years until his herds of sheep numbered 40,000 to 50,000 and his purebred herefords became a tradition among western stockmen. In recent years Etchart operated extensively in sugar beet growing.

He is survived by his widow, four sons, Leonard of Glasgow; Mark of Miles City, and Mitchell and Gene, and a daughter, Fern, all of Oxnard, Calif.
