

WOMAN FLIES TO FRANCE IN SISTER'S ILLNESS

RIVERSIDE, Nov. 26.— Word that she had reached France safely was received here today from Mrs. Maria Erramuspe of Moreno, believed to be the first woman to leave Riverside district for travel to Europe by air since the war started.

As soon as the Nazi terror blackout was lifted, Mrs. Erramuspe learned that a sister was seriously ill in France. Efforts to book passage through Portugal and Spain failed because Portugal could not guarantee transportation.

Trunks of clothing and supplies went by boat, while Mrs. Erramuspe flew by way of London.
