Her deceased husband, George W. Bisbee, was one of the fruit house officials active during the early development of the deciduous fruit industry in Placer County. He served for many years as manager of the Pioneer Fruit Company in the Newcastle district.

Mrs. Bisbee has continued to operate a deciduous fruit orchard in the Ophir district, and had visited Auburn and Newcastle on numerous occasions since moving to San Francisco.

Mrs. Blanche Wallace, who formerly resided in Newcastle, is a niece of the deceased. A daughter, Aileen Pringle of Hollywood, survives.
