

Peter Laxalt Taken by Death

Peter Laxalt, Reno resident since 1943 and before that active in cattle ranching in and near Madeline, Calif., died here Thursday night.

Mr. Laxalt was born in 1877 and in his youth he served with the Zouaves in the French army. Emigrating to the United States in 1904 he came to Reno in that year and then went to Madeline to operate his cattle ranch. He retired from that business in 1943 and came to Reno to live.

Surviving is his widow, Mrs. Mary Laxalt of Reno, two sons, Gabriel and Robert Laxalt of Susanville; two daughters, Adele Laxalt and Mrs. Lucille Etcheberry of Reno and two brothers, J. P. Laxalt of Reno and Dominic Laxalt of Carson, as well as several nieces and nephews in Carson.
