

R. Ybarrola, Resident Here 35 Years, Dies at Lynwood Home

Death of Romaldo Ybarrola, for 35 years a rancher in this valley at Pipeline and Eucalyptus avenues, on Sunday, October 17, at his home, 3615 Carlin, Lynwood, came following a lengthy illness that caused him to retire from ranching activities here about two years ago.

Funeral services were held on Thursday from St. Emedyus church in Lynwood, with rosary on Wednesday evening at Moreland mortuary in that city. Interment was in Calvary cemetery, Los Angeles.

Mr. Ybarrola was born in Spain in 1877 and came to the United States in 1902, settling in Los Angeles where he was married to Gregoria Etchevarni in 1911 and shortly thereafter came to Chino where they remained until ill health forced retirement.

The deceased is survived by his widow; one daughter, Mrs. Martina Svendsen of Lynwood; two grand-children and a brother, Ygnacio Ybarrola of Norwalk, also a former Chino resident.
