

Funeral Services Held Wednesday A. M. For Mrs. Jean Bayerque

Stricken seriously ill the week previous, Mrs. Anna Bayerque passed away Sunday morning at Memorial community hospital in Upland and final rites were held Wednesday morning from St. Margarets Catholic church with Rev. Philip T. Watz officiating. Rosary services were conducted Tuesday evening at the Heinauer-Griffith mortuary chapel.

Mrs. Bayerque was born in France on May 10, 1882, and came to the United States in 1904, settling first in Los Angeles. She and her husband later moved to Walnut, spending four years there, and then the next 10 years at Puente. For the past quarter century the family home has been at Francis and Norton streets here.

Besides her husband, Jean Bayerque, one son, John F. Bayerque of Chino, and two brothers, G. Sagousse of Chino and Jean Pierre Sagousse of France, survive.
