

BURIAL SET—Staff Sergeant Steven J. Sahargun, who was killed on Okinawa island April 29, 1945, will be buried in Union Cemetery with full military honors Monday morning. Rosary will be recited at the Hopson Mortuary chapel at 7:30 p.m. Sunday. Funeral services will begin at 9:30 a.m. Monday in St. Joseph's Church. The remains of the army hero of World War II were recently returned to United States for burial here at the request of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Sahargun, Route 1, Box 612, parents of the dead youth. The war hero was born in this city and attended Bakersfield schools. He was employed by the M & R Cattle Company at the time of his enlistment. He was 24 at the time of his death. A brother, Louis, also resides in Bakersfield.
