

## Raymon Borda's Death Reported

CARSON VALLEY, April 8. (Special) — Raymon Borda, for many years a resident of Gardnerville, died Friday evening at his home.

Born April 17, 1894, at Bivarry, France, Mr. Borda came to this country in 1912 to make Gardnerville his home. He worked in the sheep raising business, later going into business for himself and acquiring the East Fork Hotel in Gardnerville, of which he was owner and manager at the time of his death. He was widely known in Carson Valley.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Gorgonia Borda; three daughters, Mrs. Louis Corda, Mrs. Helen Oxoby and Juanita Borda; four sons, Raymond, Pete, John and Bert Borda; seven grandchildren, several nieces and nephews, and three sisters, Mrs. Juanita Anchorcoguy of Santa Barbara, Calif., Mrs. Rosalie Anchorcoguy of Red Bluff, Calif., and Mrs. Marie Uhalde of Reno.

Funeral services will be held Monday morning at 10 o'clock from St. Gall's Catholic Church in Gardnerville. Recitation of the rosary will be held today at 7:30 p.m. at the Capital City Mortuary Chapel, Carson City.
