ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE
In the matter of the Estate of: Jean Hasquet, Deceased.

Upon reading and filing the verified petition of Helen H. Blixt, Executrix of the estate of Jean Hasquet deceased, praying for leave to lease for grazing purposes the land belonging to the estate of Jean Hasquet, deceased, situated in Toole County, Montana, described as approximately 11,000 acres more or less, located in Townships 32 and 33 North, Range 3 West, Toole County, Montana, including both land owned in fee by Jean Hasquet, deceased, and land held under lease by the said deceased, excepting and excluding from the said lease approximately 320 acres of land being farmed: PROVIDED HOWEVER, that the lessee shall have the right and privilege to graze the stubble on said farm land when no crop is growing or it does not interfere with the farming operations on said 320 acres

M. of said day, then and there to show cause, if any they have, why the above described real estate should not be leased for grazing purposes for a period of one (1) year commencing on the 1st day of October, 1950 and expiring on the 10th day of October, 1951 at a rental of \$4,000.00, payable \$2,000.00 on the 1st day of October, 1950 and \$2,000.00 on or before April 1st, 1951 and
