

Woman's Body Found Off Weber Point

The body of Mrs. Susan Devaney, 36, reported missing from St. Joseph's Hospital since January 9, was recovered in Stockton Channel, off Weber Point, Saturday afternoon.

The discovery was made by Mrs. Fay Hayes, 702 N. San Joaquin who saw the body floating in the water and notified boat house operators.

Mrs. Devaney, who resided at 1307 W. Acacia, reportedly had threatened to jump into the channel several times before her disappearance. She had been under treatment in the hospital for a nervous disorder.

The victim and her husband, Jack, operated the Webster Ranch near Linden. It was reported she was living with relatives on West Acacia during her recent illness.

Officers said Mrs. Devaney's body was fully clothed when recovered. An investigation revealed it had been in the water several weeks.

In addition to her husband, Mrs. Devaney is survived by a brother, John Predagne of Oakland.

Private funeral services will be held at 11:30 a. m. tomorrow in DeYoung Memorial Chapel.
