

Romualdo Errota, Early Resident, Dies of Illness

Romualdo Errota, 13644 Central avenue, a resident of Chino since 1909, died at Pomona Valley Community Hospital Jan. 13 at 12:35 p.m., of pneumonia and complications, including heart condition.

The rosary was said at Griffith Chapel Friday, Jan. 15, at 8 p.m., and mass was conducted by Rev. Fr. Michael O'Day at St. Margaret's Catholic church Saturday, Jan. 16, at 10 a.m. Griffith Mortuary was in charge of all arrangements.

The deceased was born in Spain May 29, 1887, and was a rancher in Chino since 1909.
