

Fallon Area Rancher Dies

FALLON — John Vicondo, a resident of Fallon since 1923, died Friday in a local hospital after a brief illness. He was 64.

The Rosary will be recited Monday night at 7:30 o'clock at Austin Funeral Chapel. Requiem Mass will be celebrated Tuesday at 10 a.m. at St. Patrick's Catholic Church with Father Francis Mikula the celebrant. Burial will be in Fallon Cemetery.

Surviving is a sister, Mrs. Thomas E. Hillyard of Fallon, and a brother, Jean Bide of France.

Mr. Vicondo, a native of France, entered the United States in 1917 and settled in Winnemucca where he became a sheep rancher. He continued his ranching activities in Fallon.
