

Angelo Balunda, Longtime Store Owner Dies Here

Angelo Balunda, 13242 Central Ave., died Nov. 9 at the age of 77 in Pomona Valley Community Hospital. Rosary will be recited at Griffith Chapel tonight (Thursday) at 8 p.m.

Mass is scheduled Friday at 9 a.m. in St. Margaret's Catholic church, with the Rev. Michael O'Day officiating Interment will follow at Holy Cross Cemetery in Pomona.

Mr. Balunda was born June 7, 1886 in Spain. He came to Utah in 1908 as a young man, and moved to Chino in 1925. He has lived here ever since, and was owner-operator of Angelo's Market on Central Ave.. from 1928 until his death.

Survivors are his cousins Francisco Errota, Petra Echito, Pedro Errota and Christina Caballero, all of Chino; Victor Errota of Fontana and Philomena Laurenada of Marysville.
