

Mrs. Isidora A. Espil, 77, pioneer ranching family

LITCHFIELD PARK — Mrs. Isidora Aristoy Espil, 77, member of a pioneer Arizona sheep ranching family, died Monday in Medi Centers of America, 531 W. Thomas, Phoenix.

Mrs. Espil, 201 N. Neolin, was a member of the Arizona Wool Growers Auxiliary, and the Catholic Church's Altar Society. Born in Aoiz, Navarre, Spain, she came to Glendale in 1913 from Basque country in the Pyrenees Mountains of Spain. She was the widow of Pierre Espil, who died here in 1956.
