

### Michel Urrels

Michel Urrels, 73, a native of Banca, France, died at his home in Cedarville, Calif., Feb. 11.

Rosary was said at the Kerr Chapel in Alturas, and the funeral was at St. James Catholic Church in Cedarville with burial in the family plot in the Cedarville Cemetery.

Urrels, one of a family of eight children, came to the United States in 1916 and worked first in Coalinga, Calif., and then moved to Fort Bidwell. He was a sheep herder for six years and then engaged in livestock raising until his retirement in 1958.

He became a citizen of the U.S.A. in 1935. He was a member of the B.O.P.E. No. 1756 of Alturas, and a member of the California Wool Growers Association for over 25 years.

He married Marie Saldubere of Aldudes, France in San Francisco.

They moved from Fort Bidwell to Cedarville in 1941.

Besides his widow, Marie, he is survived by his daughter, Yvonne Etchebarne and four grandchildren; Jeanne, Michel, Annette and Jeannette all of Cedarville; one brother, St. Martin Urrels of Banca, France and numerous cousins.
