CHINO — Chino native John Chilibolost was found dead last Wednesday on the John Coudures Ranch in Moreno where he worked and resided.

The Riverside County coroner's office said he died of natural causes.

Mr. Chilibolost was born Oct. 1, 1715. He was a veteran of World War II and a member of St. Margaret's Catholic Church.

Surviving are his widow, Irene; two daughters, Mrs. Shirley Baker of Alameda and Mrs. Lynn Berklas of Simi Valley; two sons, William John of Riverside and Richard Alan of Ft.
