Pete Hualde, 94, of Ogden, died Thursday at the Weber Memorial Hospital in Roy of causes incident to age.

Mr. Hualde was born Oct. 3, 1881, in France, a son of Francis and Maria Hualde.

In August of 1922 he was married to Marguerite Mathieu in Ogden. She died July 11, 1957.

He had been a sheepman, and employe of the Ogden Golf and Country Club, retiring 25 years ago.
