BUFFALO, Wyo. — Catherine Harriet, widow of Simon Harriet, who settled 59 years ago in Buffalo, died Tuesday, at age 90, at her home.

Born in Arneguy, B.P., France, she came to Buffalo in 1920, and was married that year. Her husband died in 1975.

She had been active in the Navy Mothers Club, Johnston County Woolgrowers Association, the St. John Altar and Rosary Society, the VFW Auxiliary, and the American Legion

Auxiliary.
