John Etchart Jr.

WINNEMUCCA — John Etchart Jr., 73, died Wednesday at his residence.

A native of Golconda, he was born April 8, 1908, to John and Grace Bidart Etchart.

Etchart was manager of the Nevada-Massachusetts Tungston Mine during the 1940s, and worked for Riley Mine with Union Carbide in the 1950s.

He was in the general contracting business for several years and was one of the backers of the plan to bring translator TV to Winnemucca from Reno.

Etchart was a member of St. Paul's Catholic Church and the Humboldt County Fish and Game Commission.

Surviving are his widow, Marie, and sisters, Grace Duvivier and Yvonne Lawrence, both of Winnemucca; stepdaughter, Donna Henry of Greeley, Colo.; sister, Mary Zelayeta of Lovelock; and brothers, David of McDermitt and Benjamin of Golconda.

A brother, George, died in July 1975.

Recitation of the rosary is scheduled for 7:30 p.m. today at Eddy's Funeral Home.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Saturday at the Catholic church.

Burial will be at the Winnemucca Cemetery.
