EUREKA — Recitation of the rosary is scheduled for 7:30 p.m. today at St. Brendan's Catholic Church for Pete Etcheverry, 91, who died Saturday in a Winnemucca hospital.

A native of Arneguy, France, he was born Oct. 22, 1894, and was a longtime resident of Eureka, having moved to the United States in 1913.

He was a retired sheep and cattle rancher, and was a member of the Winnemucca Basque Club and the Nevada Wool Growers Association.
