ELKO — A rosary for Veronica Hachquet, 95, who died Sunday at the Ruby Mountains Manor Care Center will be recited at 7 p.m. today at Walton's Chapel of the Valley, Carson City.

A native of Aldudes, France, she was born Dec. 2, 1892, and moved to Reno in 1913.

She and her husband, Nazareth, later moved to Gardnerville to work in the sheep business, later moving to Elko, where they were in the hotel business, and to Carson City where they were in the motel business.

Mrs. Hachquet moved to Elko in 1977 and was a member of the Catholic church.

Her husband, died March 5, 1971, and daughters, Pauline Bath, on Aug. 27, 1950, and Isabel Gold, March 17, 1983.

Surviving are a son, Ernest, and daughters, Adele Brust and Marge Wunderlich, all of Elko; son, Albert of Burlingame, Calif.; daughter, Helen Turcott of Burke, Va.; 15 grandchildren; and 21 great-grandchildren.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday at St. Teresa of Avila Catholic Church, with burial at the Lone Mountain Cemetery, both in Carson City.
