

Jeanne Coscarart Etchegaray

A Mass of Christian Burial for Jeanne Coscarart Etchegaray, 88, who died May 21, 1993, at Hearthstone of Northern Nevada, Sparks, will be celebrated at 10 a.m. today at Our Lady of the Snows Catholic Church.

A native of Urepel, France, she was born Dec. 25, 1904, and had been a Reno resident since 1945, coming from Eureka, Nev. She moved to Eureka in 1926, coming from France.

Mrs. Etchegaray and her husband, Michael, owned the Nevada Club Tavern and handball court, which later became a dance hall in Eureka. They owned and operated the La Riviera Guest House in Reno from the late 1940s to early 1950s. A homemaker, she was a member of Our Lady of the Snows Catholic Church.

Her husband died in 1956. Surviving are her daughter, Madeline Prina, sister, Marie Iratcabal, and brother, Jean Baptiste Coscarart, all of Reno; brother, John Coscarart; three grandchildren; six great-grandchildren; and numerous nieces and nephews.

Burial will at Our Mother of Sorrows Cemetery, under the direction of Walton Funeral Home, Reno.
