

Virgil F. Parrill

Feb. 14, 1921-Jan. 12, 2001

A funeral service for Virgil F. Parrill, 79, of Jefferson, Texas, will be held at 11 a.m. Friday at the Bryan Funeral Home. Burial will be in Irville Cemetery, where military graveside services will be held by VFW Post 1058.

Mr. Parrill, formerly of Zanesville, died Jan. 12, 2001, at the Sam Rayburn Nursing Facility in Bonham, Texas. He was born Feb. 14, 1921, in Nashport, to the late Virgil G. and Ella Lovina Francis Parrill.

Mr. Parrill, a former steelworker with Lone Star Steel in Texas and Kaiser Steel in Fontana, Calif., was very involved in the Apostolic Pentecostal Church in Jefferson and Chesterhill. He was a life member of the Disabled American Veterans, and a member of the VFW in Jefferson. He was an Army veteran of World War II, and received several medals during his service including a Purple Heart.

He is survived by his son, Virgil Tom (Elizabeth) Parrill of Garland, Texas; daughters, Diana (John) Wise of Roseville, Calif., and Kathleen (Daniel) Blais of Sabattus, Maine; grandchildren, Jennifer Blais of Portland, Maine and Andrew and Samuel Parrill of Garland; sister, Etta Kennedy of Canyon County, Calif.; brothers, Charles J. Parrill of Zanesville, Ronald E. Parrill of Zanesville and James E. Parrill of Kentucky.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brothers, William, Robert and Donald Parrill; and former wife, Jean.
