

Martin J. Etchemendy

Martin J. Etchemendy, 80, died April 2, 2002, at the University of Utah Medical Center due to complications from a fall. He was born Jan. 8, #922, in Golconda to Martin and Jeanne Hauscarriague Etchmendy.

He was raised and schooled in Elko and graduated from Elko high school in 1941. He served Etchemendy with the U.S. Navy from 1942 until 1947 in the



Pacific Theater. He returned to Elko and started with the Western Pacific Railroad in 1949 and retired in 1983 as a locomotive engineer.

After his retirement from the railroad he and Margaret spent winters in southern Nevada, Arizona and Southern California. He also spent time checking out rural Nevada, his beloved state.
