

Fred B. Guillemet

Sixty-eight-year Chino resident Fred B. Guillemet, 71, died Sept. 9, 2005, at San Antonio Community Hospital, Upland.

He was born October 13, 1933, in Stockton. He was student

body president at Chino High School in 1951. He earned his master's degree from UCLA. He became a plant pathologist for the University of California, Riverside, and retired after 37 years. He had an avocado stock root patent, and was considered a preeminent expert in his field.

He was a member of St. Margaret Mary Catholic Church, Chino, and the Southern California Basque Club; was a youth baseball coach in Chino; and was a lifelong UCLA, L.A. Dodger, and Notre Dame fan.

Fred is survived by his wife, Lucille Guillemet; son, John P. Guillemet of Ontario; and one grandson. He was preceded in death by his daughter, Karen Guillemet, in 1982.

A funeral Mass was celebrated Wednesday at St. Margaret Mary. Interment followed in Bellevue Memorial Park Mausoleum.
