

SHOOTING CASE TO REACH JURORS TODAY

Trial of Tony Diaz, Spaniard, charged with assault with intent to kill his wife, Isadora Inda Diaz, by shooting her on the Plaza on May 26, will probably reach the jury by not later than 3 o'clock this afternoon.

The defense rested yesterday afternoon at 3 o'clock, whereupon the jury was taken to the cabin of Diaz that they might learn the status of the proceedings that followed just before the shooting, when Diaz jumped over a board fence in the rear and started after his wife, who was about to take a seat in an auto.

The state introduced Arnauld Inda, Mike Inda, Marcelline Menta and John Menta, who testified concerning the abuse heaped upon Mrs. Diaz by the defendant.

Dr. A. F. Adams, city physician, was the first witness called by the defense, and when asked if he believed Diaz to be mentally deranged stated that he considered him perfectly sane at the time of the shooting.

Nellie Harvey and Harry F. Harvey testified to having seen Mrs. Diaz out riding in an auto on different occasions, while Jose Orico, a partner of Diaz in the Owl club, told of Diaz becoming excitable at times.
