

## Jean Errotabere

Jean Errotabere, 55, died Saturday at his Riverdale home of a self-inflicted gunshot wound.

A native of France, he served in the French Army during World War II and had come to Riverdale in 1948 to work at his uncle Juan Errotabere's ranch.

A sheep rancher for 30 years, he owned and operated the Errotabere ranch west of Riverdale. He was a member of the Five Points Lions Club and the Los Banos, Bakersfield and Elko, Nev., Basque clubs.

Surviving are his wife, Georgianne Errotabere of Riverdale; three sons, Daniel, John and Remi Errotabere, all of Riverdale; two brothers, Vincent Errotabere of Riverdale and Ferdinand Errotabere of France, and four sisters, Marilou Saldivar of Selma and Marie Verges, Anita Gey and Marie Theresa Blanchard, all of France.

Rosary will be recited tonight at 8 in St. Ann's Catholic Church, Riverdale. Mass will be offered Tuesday at 10 a.m. in the church, followed by burial in Oak Grove Cemetery, Laton.
