ELY — Jean Goyhenetche, 76, died Sept. 18, 1992, at his residence.

A native of Les Aldudes, France, he was born Nov. 25, 1915, and had been an Ely resident since 1929.

Goyhenetche was a rancher, grocer, a hotel and tavern operator and a livestock buyer in the area for many years. He was a member of the B.P.O. Elks for 42 years and was a Fourth-Degree Knight of Columbus. He was one of the original sponsors of the Sacred Heart School.

He was preceded in death by a grandson.
