

PETER ETCHELAR DEAD.

Peter Etchelar died late Thursday night at the residence of his half-brother, Jose Boderre, at the City Hall plaza. He was generally known in the city by the name of Peter Boderre. He had not been well since he was operated on for appendicitis about a year ago, but the primary cause of his death was pneumonia, with which he was attacked about two weeks ago. He was 46 years of age, and has been employed as expert gardener in this city for a number of years. Besides the relatives in this city, he leaves a sister, Mrs. Maria Aguerrebehere, of Livermore, Cal., and a brother, John Etchelar, of San Diego, who has been in this city several days. His sister will arrive today, in time to attend the funeral this afternoon from the Boderre residence.
